

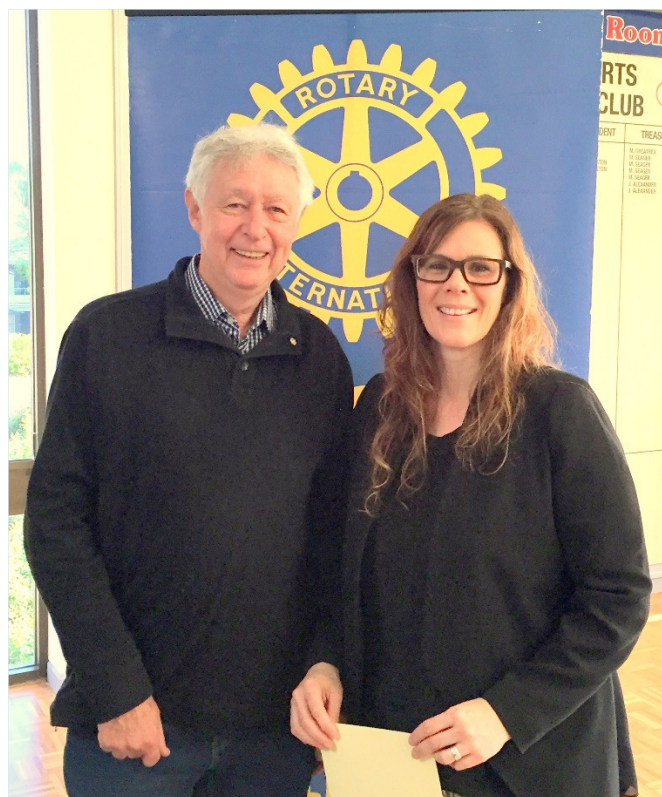


HILL'S HANSARD

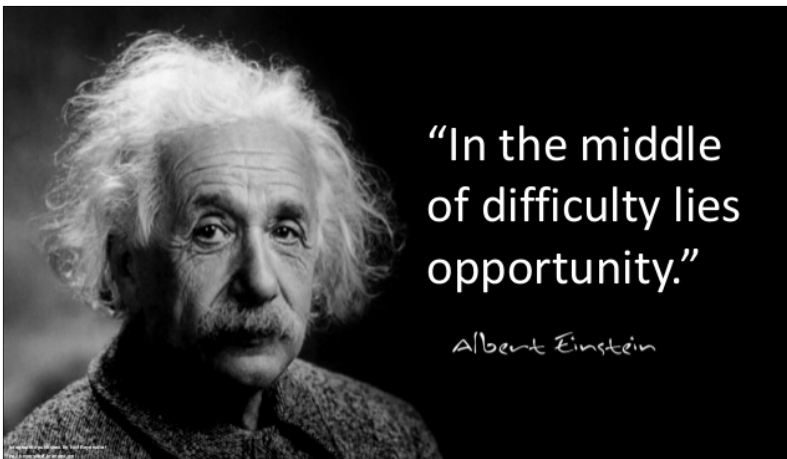

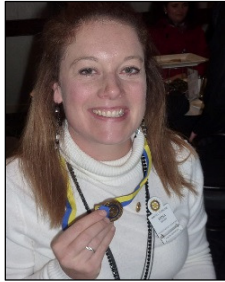


DATES FOR THE DIARY
