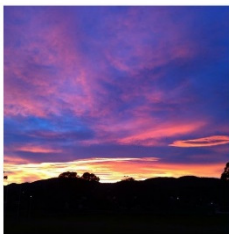
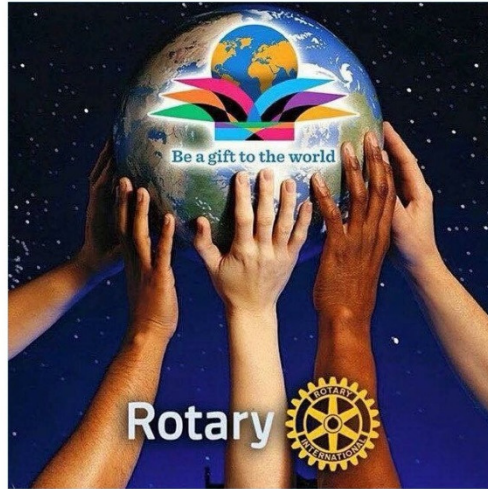




MINA'S MESSAGE

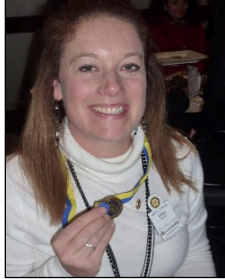
