#### Magill Sunrise's "The Reel Event" Returns for 2016

One of the highlights of the Rotary Club of Magill Sunrise's calendar is The Reel Event, an annual fundraiser showcasing a selection of the best new short films by local filmmakers. The Reel Event celebrates and displays some of the best artistic talent of our young South Australian filmmakers, with proceeds supporting a range of Rotary programs, with a focus on homelessness and youth.2016 brings the 5th edition of The Reel Event, which will be held on Wednesday May 25 at the Regal Theatre, Kensington Park (formerly the Chelsea).
