Kirsty recommends the \$10 Comedy Bonanza, which has a variety of performers, which starts at 6:00 PM

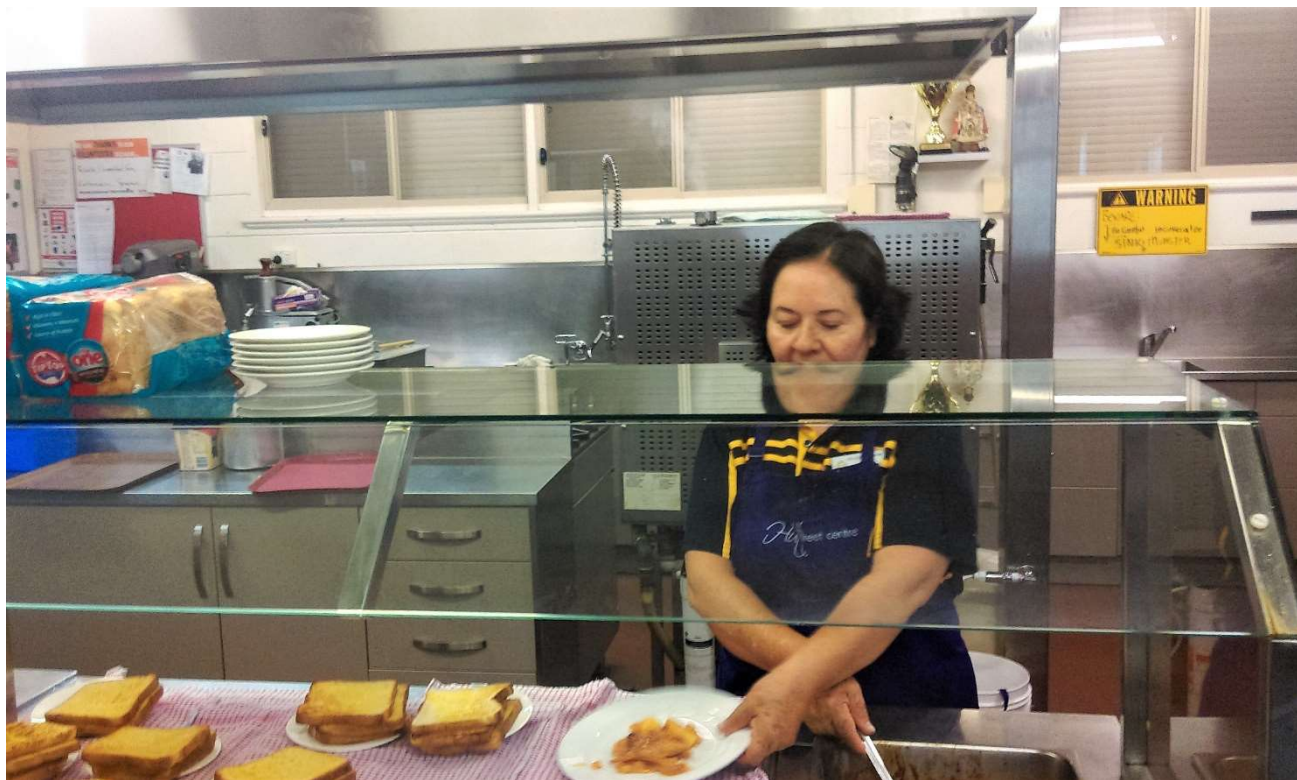
NORWOOD MORIALTA YEAR 10 'SERVICE ABOVE SELF' AWARDS 2016
