
MAGILL MARKET: THIS SUNDAY MORNING

Editor's Comment: I'm not so sure about that advice, but who am I to argue with Sherly Sandberg:

Sheryl Kara Sandberg (born August 28, 1969)^[4] is an American technology executive, activist, author, and <u>billionaire</u>. She is the <u>chief operating officer</u> (COO) of <u>Facebook</u> and founder of <u>Leanin.org</u>. In June 2012, she was elected to Facebook's <u>board of directors</u> by the existing board members,^[5] becoming the first woman to serve on its board. Before she joined Facebook as its COO, Sandberg was vice president of global online sales and operations at <u>Google</u>, and was involved in launching Google's philanthropic arm <u>Google.org</u>. Before Google, Sandberg served as <u>chief of staff</u> for <u>United States Secretary of the Treasury Lawrence</u> <u>Summers</u>.

In 2012, she was named in the <u>Time 100</u>, an annual list of the most influential people in the world according to <u>Time</u> magazine.^[6] As of June 2015, Sandberg is reported to be worth over <u>US\$</u>1 billion, due to her stock holdings in Facebook and other companies.^{[7][8]}
