**Editor’s Comment:** I’m not so sure about that advice, but who am I to argue with Sheryl Sandberg:

**Sheryl Kara Sandberg** (born August 28, 1969)<sup>[4]</sup> is an American technology executive, activist, author, and [billionaire](#). She is the [chief operating officer](#) (COO) of [Facebook](#) and founder of [Leanin.org](#). In June 2012, she was elected to Facebook’s [board of directors](#) by the existing board members,<sup>[5]</sup> becoming the first woman to serve on its board. Before she joined Facebook as its COO, Sandberg was vice president of global online sales and operations at [Google](#), and was involved in launching Google’s philanthropic arm [Google.org](#). Before Google, Sandberg served as [chief of staff](#) for [United States Secretary of the Treasury Lawrence Summers](#).

In 2012, she was named in the [Time 100](#), an annual list of the most influential people in the world according to [Time](#) magazine.<sup>[6]</sup> As of June 2015, Sandberg is reported to be worth over [US\\$1 billion](#), due to her stock holdings in Facebook and other companies.<sup>[7][8]</sup>
