President's Report

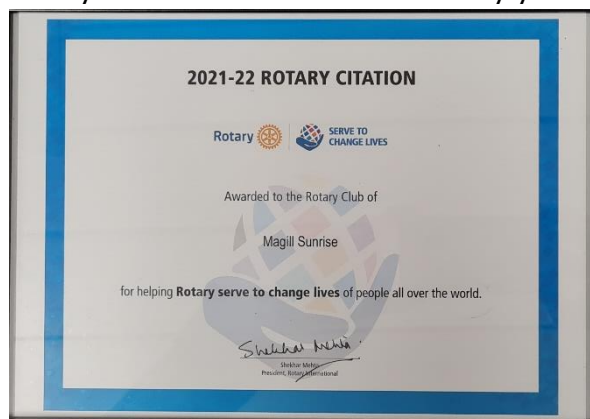
The fact that our club has been "cited" is worth celebrating.

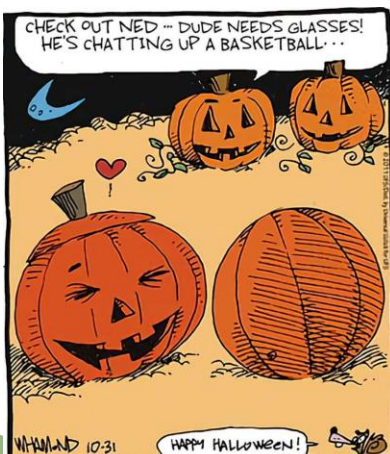
