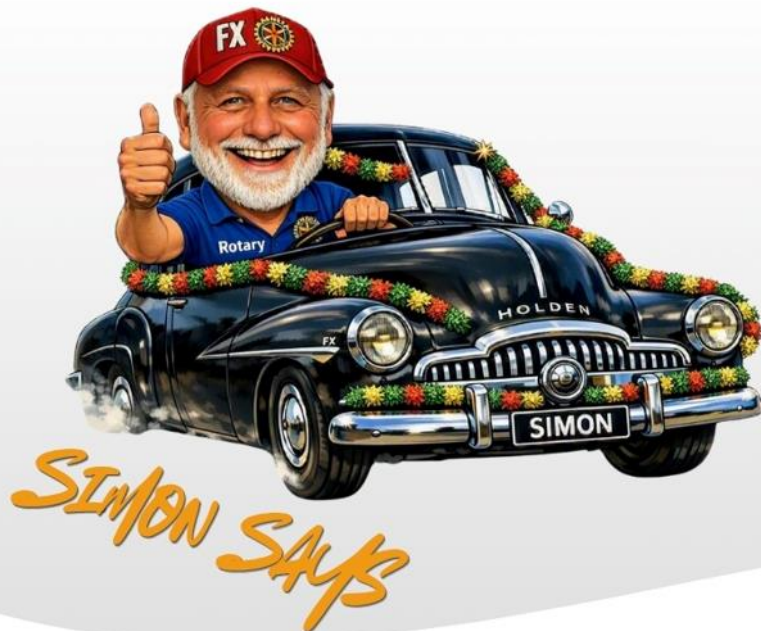

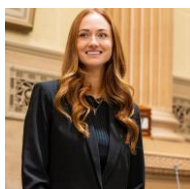

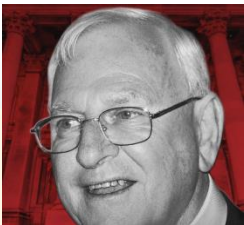


ROTARY CLUB OF MORIALTA'S 2000th MEETING

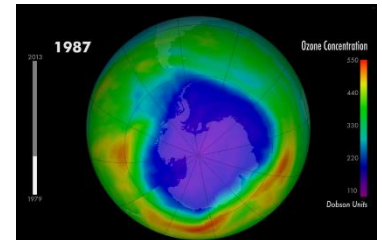
Strange & Curious Facts About Today in History

On this day, 16 September 1987, the nations of the world did something almost unprecedented. They agreed to stop using chemicals that were destroying the Earth's ozone layer.

Scientists had discovered a growing hole over Antarctica, threatening increased skin cancer, crop damage and ecosystem impacts. Through the Montreal Protocol, countries gradually phased out the offending chemicals.

The result? The ozone layer is recovering. It's one of the very few examples where humanity identified a global environmental threat, cooperated internationally and actually fixed it.

If anyone ever says people can't work together to solve world problems, the ozone layer is proof that sometimes we can.
